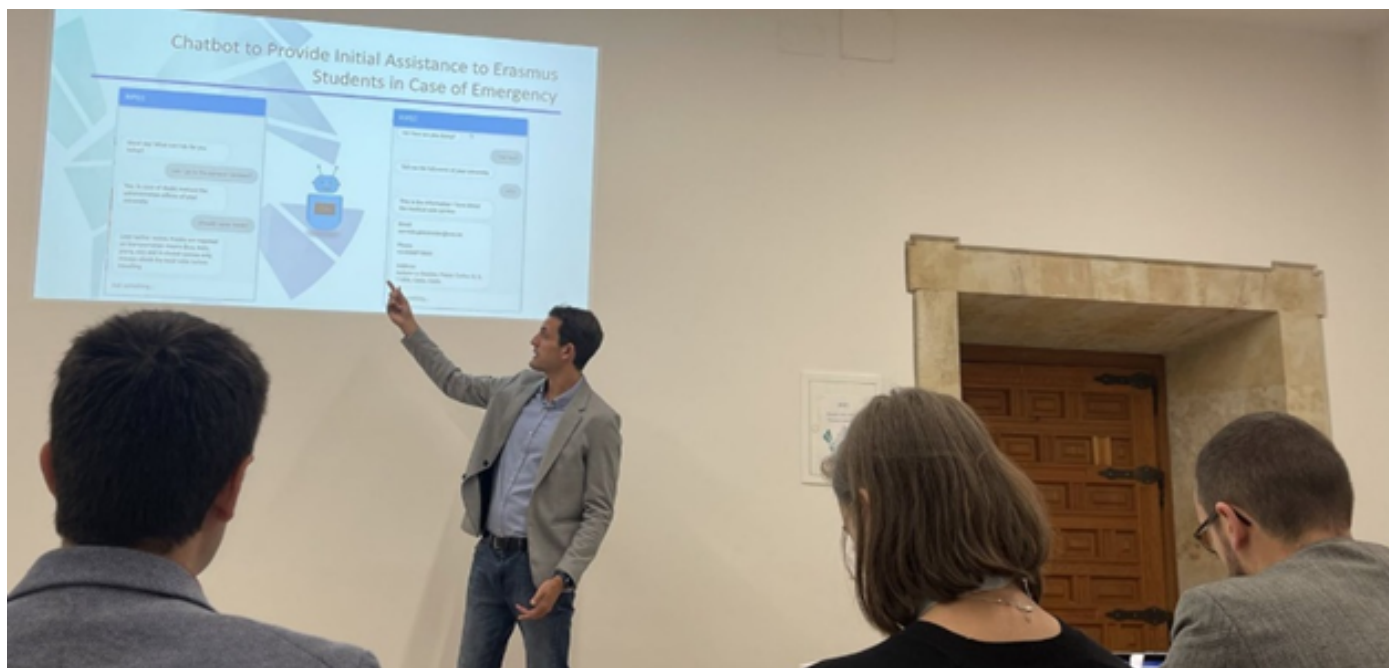
RIPEC chatbot presented at the Technological Ecosystems for Enhancing Multiculturality (TEEM 2022)
