New Condition of High Added Value


average wage of **employees** must be higher than regional average wage in a location where the investment will be effected



- A. min. 2% of estimated eligible costs will be spent on active cooperation with R&D institution
 - + university degree employees ratio higher than 10%
- B. R&D employees ratio higher than 3%
- C. min. 10% of estimated eligible costs will be spent on R&D equipment



Startup Support - Technology Incubation

- Systematic project of state support for innovative startups (250 startups)
- Funding for product/service development and consultancy services
- Incubation for 12 to 24 months
- Presence of a mentor for the entire incubation period

Sectors:

• Eco-innovation, mobility, cultural and creative industries, artificial intelligence, tech for life, advanced tech & materials, space



Technology Incubation - amount of aid

- Incubation STANDARD: support up to 1.6 million CZK
- Incubation PLUS: support up to 5 million CZK

Just Transition Fund 2021 - 2027

- 3 Regions (Usti Region, Karlovy Vary Region and Moravian-Silesian Region)
- Ministry of the Environment
- Allocatin: estimate of CZK 42 billion (Exchange rate of CZK 25/ EUR)
- The program is aimed at solving the negative impacts of diversion from coal maining
